BRAYDEN

Oh right. I'll have a--

Kylie turns her head and sees Goliath, at the other end of
the table. Her eyes widen with recognition.

KYLIE

Is that Goliath W. Lion, Guardian of
the Outward Plains?

BRAYDEN

No, sorry. It isn't.

KYLIE

Excuse me then. What did you say you
wanted?

BRAYDEN

A turkey club and a lemonade is fine.

KYLIE

You got it.

(glancing under the table)

Anything for him?

BRAYDEN

No, we'll share...

KYLIE

Plate splitting is extra. But I won't
tell if you won't. I'll be right back
with your drink.

Goliath gets up after Kylie leaves - sits across Brayden.
Kylie walks back with a DRINK.

KYLIE

I'll be back as soon as your meal is ready. Kylie exits.
Goliath gets up off the floor - again.

EXT. DINER - PARKING LOT - NIGHT

Kylie finds Brayden sitting on the curb and joins him.

KYLIE

Hey! Are you alright?

BRAYDEN

Yeah, I'm sorry about that.

KYLIE

No, I wanted to thank you. You saved me back there.

BRAYDEN

It wouldn't have started if it wasn't for me.

KYLIE

You can't worry about how others perceive you. You'll drive yourself crazy. (beat) Truth is, I don't really like working here. I hate cars.

BRAYDEN

Me too.

KYLIE

I'd much rather ride on the back of an elephant or a lion, like in that old cartoon show.

BRAYDEN

Guardian of the Outward Plains?

KYLIE

Yes! I loved that show when I was a kid! I used to watch it every Saturday morning. Goliath was my favorite.

BRAYDEN

He's-- he was mine too.

KYLIE

I loved how protective he was. He always had everyone's backs.

BRAYDEN

It was a good show. For it's time.

KYLIE

I owe you another sandwich.

BRAYDEN

No. That's okay, but thank you.

KYLIE

Are you sure? Is there anything else I can get you?

BRAYDEN

(beat) What time does your shift end?

KYLIE
